PARENT CONSENT FORM FOR THE USE OF PUPIL DATA AND IMAGES

DINNER MONEY - REMINDER TO PARENTS

Please can we remind all parents that dinner monies must be paid by 9.30am on the morning that your child is having a school lunch (£2.30 daily). Alternatively you can pay on Monday morning by 9.30am for the whole week (£11.50). Any dinner monies paid in advance and not used due to illness or your child having a packed lunch will be rolled forward to the following week.

As we are now using the School Gateway to manage all dinner monies, we are unable to accommodate any late payments of dinner monies. Therefore, where school lunches are ordered on any day of the week but no payment received online via the Gateway or in cash or cheque to the school office on that morning, parents will be required to bring in a packed lunch for their child by 12 noon.
