IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ALL YEAR 6 PARENTS WANTING A SECONDARY SCHOOL PLACE IN SEPTEMBER 2020

The application process for requesting secondary school places will CLOSE on Wednesday 31st October 2019.

Please can we remind parents that you need to apply using the online system www.devon.gov.uk/admissionsonline or by contacting My Devon, Customer Service Centre on 0345 155 1019 to request an application form. The application form should be returned either to us to post, or post directly to the Admissions Team **before 31st October 2019**.



We do not want parents to experience the disappointment that can be felt as a result of a late application – please ask to speak to a school leader or the school office if you have any questions.

HAYTOR VIEW MEDICAL INFORMATION FORMS

In September we review all medical information for children across the school and review any relevant care plans with parents.

Forms are being sent out to parents in phases. It will really help us if you could return the forms swiftly as it will enable us to ensure the relevant information is held about your child in order to support their health, well-being and safety.

Once we have your information back, where necessary a meeting will be set up with you to complete a care plan for your child.

All of our forms have been reviewed this year using the most up to date information and guidance.

SCHOOL DINNER MONEY

The cost of a school dinner remains at £2.30 per day (£11.50 per week).

Please may we remind parents that dinner money needs to be paid <u>on the morning your</u> <u>child requires a dinner, no later than 9.30am</u> – we are not able to supply a dinner to those who have not paid on time - thank you.

USE OF CAR PARK REMINDER

Please can we remind parents that the use of the car park is **not permitted at drop off and pick up times (including lunchtimes for Nursery children)**, due to the conflict between pedestrian access and vehicles.

IF YOUR CHILD IS UNWELL

If your child is unwell and absent from school, you must contact the school office to inform them. If you do not contact the school office the absence will be recorded as **unauthorised.**
