SCOOTER AND BIKE RACK USE

Many of you will be aware of the volume of scooters and bikes we have being parked in the scooter and bike racks, this is fantastic as it really encourages children to understand safe travel at an early age.

What we recognise is that it can be difficult for children to spot which bike or scooter is theirs, in recent weeks we have had several 'mix ups' with scooters which has seen children take home a scooter which they think is theirs, leaving behind the scooter which is actually theirs, therefore leaving a child without a scooter.

We appreciate it is difficult for children to identify which scooter or bike is theirs with so many children having the same make and model, this can see children take the one which looks like theirs when in fact it belongs to another child.

If you are concerned about the security of your child's scooter you are welcome to provide a padlock which can be used by your child in their use of the scooter rack, the lock will need to be taken home each day to support all children's access to the park. Likewise if you want to provide your child with a bike lock in their use of the bike rack, you are very welcome to do so.



What the school is unable to do is take any responsibility for the security of the bikes or scooters, we provide the facility to park a bike or scooter, it is up to parents whether they wish to provide additional security measures such as the ones described above.

Thank you for your help in supporting our children in using bikes and scooters to travel to school.
