TIME TO THINK

Please can we take this opportunity to remind Parents that during Time to Think 8.35am to 8.50am from Reception to Year 6, parents are responsible for the safety of their child/children. With this in mind, if your child is at risk of leaving the setting you need to either remain in the setting until 8.50am or bring your child in for the end of Time to Think.

Whilst we appreciate adults are stood both in classrooms and on the Courtyard, Parents remain the responsible 'body' for their children until the official start of the school day at 8.50am. These arrangements are in accordance with local authority guidance and are reflected in the working arrangements of most schools.

Whilst we enjoy seeing children taking part in Time to Think, we must ensure they are safe during this time. Should your child leave the class during Time to Think, the arrangements for the start of the day entry into class may need to be reviewed with the child and parent.

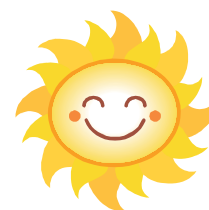
