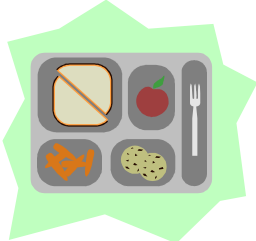
#### **HALF TERM ALREADY!!!**
