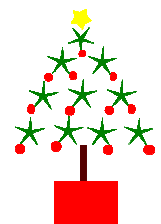

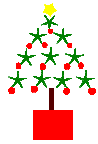


CHRISTMAS LUNCH – THURSDAY 14TH DECEMBER
