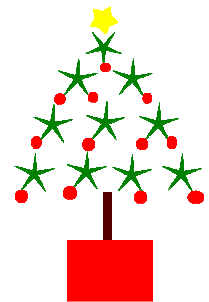

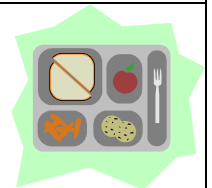
Corbyn Saunders would like to nominate Miles Anderson for an award this week, for helping the playleaders with the tidying up – this made Corbyn really happy.
