ATTENDANCE & HOLIDAY ABSENCE



The Local Authority Education Welfare Officer undertook their half termly visit this week, their particular focused was holiday absence and unauthorised absence. The Local Authority are reviewing each holiday absence case individually and issuing penalty notices where thresholds have been met, **this**

means a fine of £60 per parent per child. Where thresholds for fines have not been met, a Fast Track legal meeting will be arranged with the Education Welfare Officer. We are keen to raise your awareness where your child's absence has 'popped up' on the Local Authority 'to watch list', therefore Phase Leaders will be seeking to update you where this is the case.
