In the meantime should you have any concerns or wish to discuss your child's progress please speak to their current learning leader.

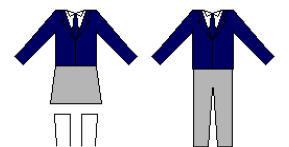
CAR PARKING ON SANDRINGHAM ROAD AND QUEENSWAY
