Curriculum Visit – St Luke's Church – Christmas 2019

On Tuesday 17th December children from Years 1 – 6 will be visiting St. Lukes Church to experience and share in a celebration relating to the festival of Christmas. The visit, which sits within the school's curriculum, will provide an experience supporting the children's awareness of the background relating to this festival and see them sharing in related songs, stories and poetry, led by Fr. Nick Debney, who will now be familiar to many of you as a result of his engagement with the school.

It is a legal curriculum requirement that the school provide opportunities for children to be engaged with acts of worship of a broadly Christian nature reflecting the traditions of Christian belief. The aims of the visit to St Lukes are to:
