School Closure - Free School Meals – IMPORTANT UPDATE
Delivered packed lunch or Voucher/eGift Card to spend on food?

Dear Parents/Carers,

Following recent letters around free school meals, after the Easter break we are pleased to be able to offer one of the two following choices to support you in ensuring that your child receives a healthy meal each day, free of charge.

- Packed lunch, freshly prepared in the school kitchen each day, delivered to your door between 12.00 – 1.00pm. Ham, Cheese, or Egg Mayonnaise based lunches are available.
- A weekly voucher (£15 for each child in receipt of free school meals each week), accessed via email and spent using your smartphone (by email or screenshot of email if you've run out of data) at Sainsbury's, Tesco, Morrisons, Asda, M&S and Waitrose.

We know that the choice that you make will be down to individual circumstances - we just need to hear from you. We are keen to hear from everyone – you are entitled to this support and we are hopeful one of the choices available should fit you and your family.

We just need to know your child's name(s), and which one of the two options, packed lunch or voucher, you choose.

There is further information about the voucher scheme attached to this letter – we would expect that codes for voucher purchase will be received in your email inbox by the end of the first school week after Easter. Packed lunches will be delivered from Tuesday 14th April.

We will of course keep you in the picture with any further developments in the provision of meals for children over the coming weeks.
