

### **School Uniform Statement**

Being appropriately dressed greatly helps children in being ready to learn and distinguish between home, play and learning, therefore this is something we view as being of particular importance.

Children are expected to wear school shoes for learning sessions, they are able to change into trainers for playtime and PE.

Transfers or 'tattoos' need to be removed before the child's arrival at school, as these can detract children from their learning as they compare and contrast their body art!

Also, nail varnish need to be removed before the child's arrival at school, in order to prevent them from having the desire to 'pick at it' during their learning time!

For reasons of health and safety and safe keeping the only jewellery children are allowed to wear in school is a pair of stud earrings, any other jewellery such as bracelets, rings or necklaces need to be left at home. Stud earrings do need to be removed for PE.
