Year 5 Trip - Lantern-making at Seale Hayne

On Tuesday 3rd December, Year 5 will be visiting Seale Hayne to make lanterns ready for our involvement in the Newton Abbot Lantern Parade, which will take place on the evening of Wednesday 11th December. We are really looking forward to working with artist Tony Gee to create lanterns for this special event. The trip will take place during school hours, so please make sure your child is in class before 8:50am.

Our bus travel to and from the venue has been paid for by Newton Abbot Town Council, but there is a cost associated with the visit – a voluntary contribution of £5 will support the cost of professional instruction and all of the materials they will need to create a fantastic lantern that can be kept for years to come. Unfortunately, if insufficient contributions are received to cover these costs, the trip will be unable to take place. Of course, if that situation should arise, all monies would be refunded appropriately to those who paid.

On the day of the visit, all children will need to take with them an appropriate snack, drink and packed lunch. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, they will be provided with a packed lunch. Children will also need to wear comfortable clothes that you don't mind getting slightly messy! We will return to school by 3:15 pm.
