## KEEPING OUR SCHOOL COVID SAFE - NEW NATIONAL GUIDANCE

As expected we are seeing an increase in COVID cases in Devon, as the OMICRON variant continues to work its way across the country. We have this week seen Mrs Cousins unfortunately receive a positive diagnosis – she is well in herself and we hope to see her back with us soon.

Given the bigger picture we've reviewed our risk assessment processes in line with the local authority advice and continue to be satisfied that our enhanced cleaning and hygiene

provision is supporting our aim in being COVID safe.

We would encourage families to continue to support children and adults in the home with regular lateral flow testing - you've done a great job of supporting our school community so far – thank-you.

If children receive a positive lateral flow test they should start to self-isolate for 10 days. It is now possible to end self-isolation and return to school after 5

full days if you have 2 negative lateral-flow tests taken on consecutive days. The 10 day isolation remains in place for those without negative results from 2 lateral-flow tests taken a day apart. The self-isolation period includes the day symptoms started or when you took your test and the next 10 full days ie. day 1 is the day after symptoms or test.

If a member of the family receives a positive lateral flow test, all family members should take a lateral flow tests each day to avoid self-isolation. Children can continue to attend school providing that lateral flow tests remain negative.

Your careful attention will ensure that we continue to be able to successfully provide and staff a safe environment for all. With the latest Omicron variant showing itself to be much more contagious than previous viruses, your support of the community at large is greatly appreciated.

MOST IMPORTANTLY - Should you have any concerns or questions concerning your child's health or next steps as you see symptoms or receive positive diagnoses please do not hesitate to give us a call. We will always seek to make sure that any contact that you make is worth your while.

#### MAINTAINING CONTACT WITH FAMILIES WHO ARE SELF ISOLATING

During periods of self-isolation class teachers will be making contact with families in order to discuss home learning requirements, this is part of the provision the school is required to put in place when children are self-isolating.

It is essential that class teachers are able to make contact with you in order to establish what we are able to provide in the way of support.

Following on from our impromptu fire evaluation on our first day back, we've had the opportunity to review our procedures.

Firstly a huge 'thank you' to parents for supporting the children and staff so well during the evacuation, this saw parents and children **not seeking to return to the building** when the alarm was sounding. As this greatly enabled us to support a safe evacuation at a time when the school is busy and lots of people are out of the classroom.



Therefore moving forward, in the event that a fire alarm sounded at the end of the day please can:

- 1) Children follow the usual procedures for evacuation if they are in the classroom;
- 2) Parents to support their children, by not returning to the classroom;
- 3) If children are still in class when the alarm is sounding, the class teacher will ensure the children exit the building safely;
