DAISI ART PROJECT

This week, Year 6 had a fantastic full day learning about Silk Painting with Jess from the DAISI Art Project. They sketched images of fossils based on the work of Sam Cannon. Then they enlarged these before transferring their sketch onto the silk. Jess taught the children how to use gutta to create the pattern on the silk before using silk paints to create fantastic texture and tone. The results are amazing and will soon be on display in the school gallery.
