#### Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2023 – Meal Arrangements

We are always keen to carefully secure and invest the school's budget and resources as we seek to provide the very best opportunities and outcomes for your children. This is particularly the case at the moment as school budgets are as tight as they have ever been.

With this in mind Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> May is an important day for us – it is on this day that central government count how many children, who qualify for free school meals, actually take up this offer.
