Christmas Service – December 2025

On Monday 8th December, children from Years 1–6 will be taking part in our Christmas service, which will take place at school, starting at 2.00pm. This celebration, which forms part of our school curriculum, will support the children's understanding of the Christian festival of Christmas and provide an opportunity to share related songs, stories and prayers.

This year, year 2 children will be performing the Nativity, supported by our year 6 children, who will narrate the performance. We look forward to sharing this special event with you.

It is a legal curriculum requirement that the school provides opportunities for children to engage with acts of worship of a broadly Christian nature, reflecting the traditions of Christian belief. The aims of this service are to:

- provide our children with an opportunity for stillness and reflection;
- promote children's spiritual, moral, social and cultural development;
- celebrate the values and worth of the school community and all who belong to it;
- help children develop an understanding of the nature and language of worship;
- help children develop respect and sensitivity to the beliefs and values of others.

Parents are warmly invited to attend the service at 2.00pm, the Hub doors will open at 1:45pm.

At the end of the service, children may go home with their parent/carer. They can be collected from outside their classrooms once the service has finished.
