Dear Parents/Carers

Out of classroom learning at Decoy Park on Wednesday 2nd November 2022

On Wednesday 2nd November, we are planning to take the Year 2 children to learn at Decoy Park for the day. The purpose of this trip will be to explore the natural environment, to identify habitats and the animals that live within them, to classify trees according to their features. We will also be using the experience to use our geographical map reading skills in a real setting and weather permitting, to use our ICT skills to capture data and information from our visit.

On this occasion there is no cost attached to the trip and as a result voluntary contributions are not being requested. We will even provide a free packed lunch for every child who needs one so you don't even need to make that!

Your child will need a bag they can carry on their back. In the bag we'd like them to be carrying a labelled waterbottle, a waterproof coat and a spare pair of socks, pair of gloves and wooly hat. If your child has waterproof trousers, these would be useful to include. The children will probably get muddy, so on the day they need to be wearing a pair of old trousers and a pair of wellies. We do have a number of pairs of wellies to borrow but numbers are limited. School Jumpers will need to be worn.

We will walk down to the Park, leaving at 9:30 am and will be back at school by 3:15pm for usual collection.

If you would like to come with us, please feel free to stay with us on the morning of the trip and walk down with us. We will maintain responsibility for your children during the trip – this means that you could meet us at the park or even join us for part of the day if you wish.
