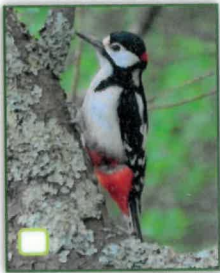


Decoy Country Park and Local Nature Reserve

Keep an eye on the changing seasons and the first time you see or hear a Chiffchaff or Swallow in the spring or Pochard and Tufted Duck after the autumn frosts.

Through the year there is always something exciting to see from courting Grebes to grappling Coots, Decoy's biggest wild bird the Mute Swan to some of the smallest such as Coal Tits, Wrens and Goldcrests.

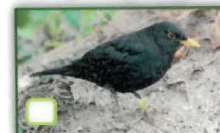
