## Autumn Half Term 1 – Foundation Stage 1 (Nursery) Forest School Sessions

Our F1 Forest School sessions are starting the week beginning 22<sup>nd</sup> September – next week!  
They will run on both Monday and Friday afternoons from 1.15pm—2.45pm.

We are limiting the groups to 8 children and adults to ensure that safe social distancing measures can be followed. When you have signed up and have been allocated a session, please arrive for 1.15pm at the school hub so that we can complete the necessary registration forms.

We will meet in the school hall where a group register will be taken. Mrs Breakwell our Forest School Leader will also talk through our risk assessment. Your child will be allocated a pair of waterproof trousers and jacket which they need to wear to attend the forest school session.

Please come to school dressed in trousers or leggings with long sleeved top and wearing wellington boots – that's both adults and children. Adults are welcome to wear walking shoes or sturdy trainers instead of wellies if you do not have any. Bear in mind that whatever you are wearing may get a bit mucky.

If you plan to leave your child with us for the Forest School session we would ask that you stay with your child until they have been registered and changed into their Forest School waterproofs.
