

Here are some examples of the rhymes you can create!

## Rhyme Time!

Silly rhymes can help children learn tricky tables, e.g.

$8 \times 8 = 64$  He ate and ate and was sick on the floor, eight  
times eight is 64.

$3 \times 3 = 9$  Swing from tree to tree on a vine, three times three  
is nine.

$7 \times 7 = 49$  Seven times seven is like a rhyme, it all adds up to  
49.
