(Number Bonds)

You have been working hard on your number bonds.

Knowing that $4 + 6 = 10$, you also know that

$$14 + 6 = 20$$

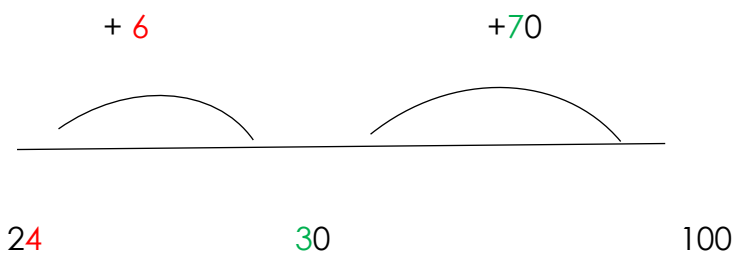
$$40 + 60 = 100$$

$$400 + 600 = 1000$$

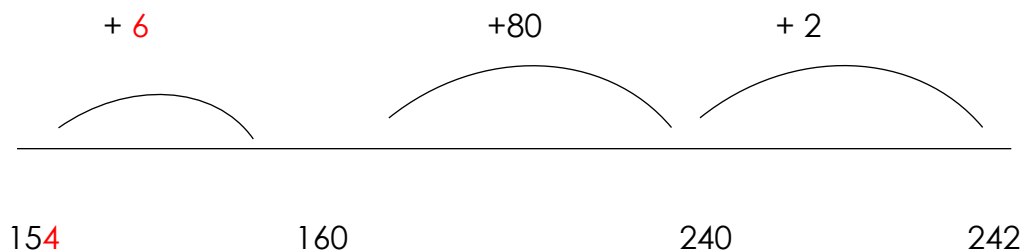
Knowing all your number bonds to 10 can also help you with other calculations:

$$\begin{array}{c} 24 + 76 \\ \swarrow \quad \searrow \\ 70 \quad 6 \end{array}$$

Partition the number (shown above).



$$\begin{array}{c} 80 \\ \swarrow \\ 154 + 88 \\ \swarrow \quad \searrow \\ 6 \quad 2 \end{array}$$
