Number line creating

With this in mind today's challenge for maths is to create a number line using this template from 0-20.

In school you are used to number lines which you can write on and wipe clean for re-use. If you would like to create a number line 'buddy' to mark your place when counting, I have added some templates for you to use. There is a choice from the BFG, Fantastic Mr Fox, Willy Wonka or Matilda. Or, create your own, please remember these characters are for you to use to help you when using the number line. Tomorrow you will have a sheet of addition to practice with and may need to use your number line, so have fun getting ready for the task!
