Dear Parents/Carers,

Have you heard? Our nursery is nearly full!

You may have read on the newsletter issued this week that we are faced with a very positive position in respect of our nursery. For the first time since Haytor View opened its doors as a primary school we will soon be seeing a picture where all available spaces for children have been taken. As things stand we still have some availability but only in certain sessions, and we expect this capacity to be taken up very soon.

This is a sign of good health for the school and the community at large, as the majority of children that join our nursery progress through the school to Year 6, and healthy class sizes mean that we can make more secure decisions around provision for your children.

I am keeping you in the picture about this however, because the demand for places in our nursery means that we will soon be having to run a waiting list for places in our nursery provision – this means that parents cannot assume that places will be available for their children when they need them. Critically this means that if you, or anyone you know, are planning for your child to join our school community starting in the nursery **we need to hear from you as early as possible – this will give you the best chance of securing a place for your child.**

With this in mind we would ask that you make family members, friends or neighbours aware of this position so that, as far as possible we can avoid unnecessary disappointment.
