Children's Safe Use of the Internet in School

From time to time it is important that we review the measures that we have in place to keep children safe online while in school. One aspect of this is ensuring that our agreement with you, parents and carers, reflects the ever-changing online world and children's experiences in school.

With this in mind we have developed and updated the **Internet Acceptable User Agreement** that we ask all parents to sign to provide your permission for children to use the internet while in school. Amongst other things this seeks to ensure that school systems and users are protected from accidental or deliberate misuse. Such misuse could put people or systems at risk.

In order that our records are up to date and to ensure that we have effective and appropriate permission from you for your child to use the internet while at school, we would ask you to read, sign and return the Internet Acceptable User Agreement that your child will be bringing home over the next few days.

We would be more than happy to read this agreement through with you, to explain or discuss any aspects of the document. If you think that this would be useful just speak to your child's teacher who will make the necessary arrangements to share some time with you.
