<u>Christmas Celebration – St. Luke's Church, Milber</u> <u>Tuesday 14th December – 1.30pm</u>

As you know we are planning to visit St. Luke's Church, Milber for a Christmas celebration involving children from Years 1-6. We are really pleased that Father Nick has been able to invite us along to the church, where all visitors will requested to conform to guidance that he has in place in relation to COVID. These arrangements will be made clear upon your arrival and we hope that this doesn't get in the way of parents and family members joining us.

Children will be sat at the front of the church within class groups for the telling of the Christmas story, songs and prayers.

Ahead of the event, classes will walk down to the church together, leaving school around 1.00pm. You are welcome to walk with your child if you wish, and we would ask that you wait on the Queensway drive and join your child as they depart if this is the case.

Following the event, all visitors will be asked to leave the church and wait outside ahead of children then leaving the church. Should you wish to take your child home immediately following the event they may be collected outside the church as they leave. These arrangements have been put in place to allow everyone to feel comfortable about the environment and to avoid any crowding or sustained and unnecessary close contact.

We look forward to seeing as many of you as possible for what we hope will be an enjoyable and safe way to get together and celebrate Christmas.

All we now need is permission for your child to attend the event – a permission slip will be coming home with your child for you to complete and return to us. We would ask that this is returned as soon as possible to support the arrangements that we are making.
