Free School Meal - Vouchers

The voucher service replacing Free School Meals is well underway now – top up vouchers that reflect the increase in value from $\pounds 25$ to $\pounds 30$ each fortnight that the government agreed from last week will be with you very shortly. The good news is that vouchers for children who qualify for Free-School Meals will also be issued for half term using the same providers that we use. So you'll see no change how these are coming through to you for that week.

With our second batch of laptops for children now in school we are pleased that these are flying out to families where these will support engagement with remote learning.
