To help us sing it, I made a green cardboard mountain:



Then I made a brown cardboard bear:



The bear can walk over the mountain and then turn to face it going the other way as the song goes on.

So that we can extend the song further, I used an old tissue box. I taped a different preposition on plain card on each side of the box. These include under, behind, above, next to, in front of, below and behind. This 'cube' can be thrown each time so that the word 'over' and the actions can be changed each time the song is sung. This can be great fun!
