Torbay Music Festival – Friday 1st March 2024

Over the Spring term, children in Years 3 and 4 have been engaging in whole class instrumental sessions with Kip Pratt. In addition eight children from across Key Stage 2 have been engaging in weekly one-to-one music sessions. We are grateful that all of these sessions are grant-funded by Torbay Music Festival who have asked whether children taking part will share a short performance during their annual festival week in March.

Given the financial support that the festival offers the school, we are really keen to show them what their investment has brought to our children. With this in mind Kip and I have been working closely with the festival team to make arrangements that will mean that children can comfortably showcase their talent and the compositions they have been working on.

The festival will take place on Friday 1st March 2024 at 1:15pm, at the Palace Theatre in Paignton. The children will be taken to the festival by coach and will be accompanied by myself, Mrs Brown, Mrs Russell, Miss Wicks, Miss Minney, Miss Leather and Mr Scott. Following the performances the coach will return to school by the end of the day.

If you would like to come and watch your child's performance, you can purchase a ticket for the festival at a discounted cost of £3.50 per adult, children are free. If you do choose to attend, once the performances have finished, you are welcome to take your children before we return to school.

Your child will be bringing home a reply slip requesting your permission for your child to attend. If you choose to buy tickets, do let us know so that we can look forward to seeing you there.
