# What have we been up to already?

#### Year 3

Michael from Paddleboat Theatre has been working with Year 3 as part of a 'Talking Turns' project. The project focusses on how oracy and drama can support children's writing. The children have been exploring poetry. They have been engaging in group work, using tableaus and freeze frames to create a stimulus for their own group poems.









This term, Kip Pratt (our visiting peripatetic teacher) has been working with year 3 in music, delivering whole class instrumental tuition on the recorders. The children have engaged well with the lessons. The children were able to perform their musical talents at the Torbay Music Festival and did incredibly well!



### Year 4

The children have been learning about volcanoes and spent time creating amazing posters and models. The knowledge of the children has been fantastic. The children had an amazing time experimenting with erupting volcanoes!
